Re: Artificial Ice Rink Openings

Dear Councillor Bailao:

I am writing in response to your email dated November 19, 2012.

Refrigeration compressors for aritificial ice rinks that we are working to open on November 24<sup>th</sup> are operating. Hand flooding of these rinks begins tonight. Flooding will continue in the evenings. The weather is warm right now but the forecast shows a drop late Friday and into the weekend with temperatures favourable for making and maintaining ice. The current warm, sunny conditions are challenging but we are making every effort to have ice available as soon as possible. Weather permitting, the rinks that are scheduled to open this weekend will remain open until March 10, 2013. The remaining outdoor artificial ice rinks, weather permitting, are scheduled to open Dec. 1, 2012 and close Feb. 24, 2013.

Although CIMCO has informed Ms. Mason that ice can be made in 10 degrees Celsius, our past experience has proven otherwise. Weather, including sun, ground temperatures, physical plant, and type of refridgerant are all factors. The upcoming days of weather have predicted highs approaching 9 or 10 degrees until Saturday when it drops. It is 10 and sunny outside today.

Our experience from 2011 was that we did in fact have substantial problems with all of our rinks with the exception of Dufferin Grove. All of the early opening rinks were totally unskateable at the temperatures that were lower than present conditions. The following chart highlights experience from last year even though compressors were turned on a full week earlier with night time floods and temperatures that were slightly lower than present conditions.
