Permitted Activity	Putting on a play in a park*	Making a film in a park
Underlying permit philosophy	consistency, standardization, equitable access to PFR facilities, and scarcity	collaboration, respect, working together to create a positive experience, requests
Time required to issue permit	6 weeks	2 business days; 4 days if request for road closures, multi-lane closures and special effects
Insurance required:	yes	yes
Permit process	see permit application	secure on-line application
Permit fees	varies from \$74.38 to \$391.37	free
