**Subject: City of Toronto Access Request Number 2012-00615**

I am replying to your access request under the *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*. Enclosed is a receipt for your application fee.

You have requested access to "a copy of records containing the number of tickets issued for parking illegally in the disabled parking space located near 1173 and 1175 Bloor Street West from January 1, 2011 to February 25, 2012, and also separately from February 26, 2012 to present."

We asked staff of Municipal Licensing and Standards (MLS), Transportation Services (TS) and also Revenue Services (RS) to conduct a search for records responsive to your request. This decision reflects the results of their search.

**Access to the Records**

Staff of Revenue Services (RS) found the information you requested by creating a computer program to compile the list of records that respond to your request.

The search by staff of MLS and TS has found no records that respond to your request. Access cannot therefore be granted, as no such records exist.

**Fees**
