1406 ICE SKATING PROTECTIVE HELMET POLICY

Preamble

The mandatory wearing of a Canadian Standard Association (CSA) approved

protective helmets for ice sports by all participants, for their protection and

safety during ice skating activities at City of Moncton arenas, is an important

initiative for the Parks & Leisure Services Department, user groups, and the

public at large.

1406.01 Policy Statement This policy was implemented for the safety and

wellbeing of all users while participating in ice skating activities at City of

Moncton arenas.

1406.02 Policy

All participants during ice related activities at all City of Moncton ice skating

arenas shall wear a Canadian Standards Association (CSA) approved protective

helmet for ice sports.

This policy will be clearly posted with the other established regulations for

activities and placed at the entrance of Moncton's skating arenas.

1406.03 Exception

Figure skaters who are registered with Skate Canada and after successfully completing the Can Skate program as well as figure skating competitors during sanctioned competitions are exempt from wearing a protective helmet during

these activities as standard practice in the sport which is supported by Skate

Canada, Skate New Brunswick and Mariposa Skating Club in Moncton.

This policy would not apply to team personnel during bookings made by the

teams associated with the Quebec Major Junior Hockey League.
